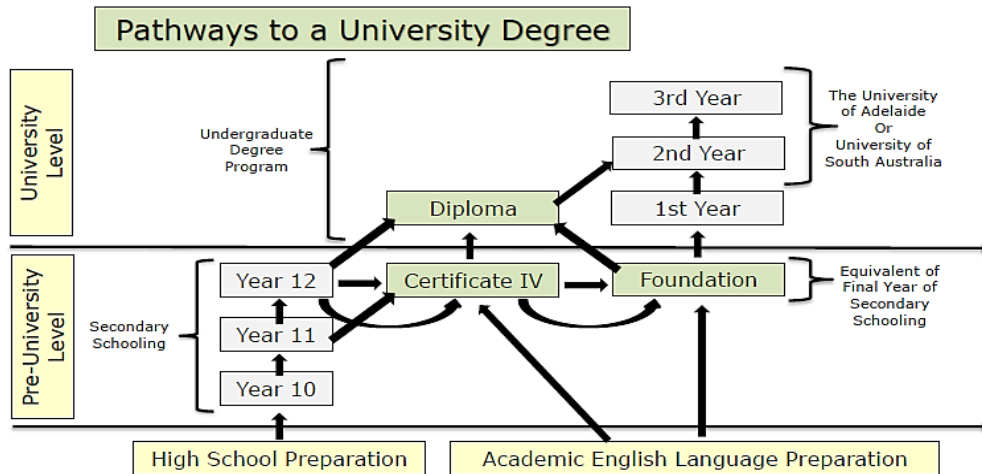


Paving Positive Pathways: Pre-university Programs and Professional Partnerships

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Eynesbury incorporates (1) Eynesbury College, (2) Eynesbury College Academy of English, and (3) Eynesbury Institute of Business and Technology, which offer a range of pathways to *The University of Adelaide* or the *University of South Australia*. The route is not always linear and seamless, but with effective collaboration and substantive contributions by academic and professional staff—as well as stakeholders—in a common educative endeavour the pathway is made smoother.



Eynesbury Foundation Studies Program (FSP)

- FSP students are given provisional entry into a bachelor degree program of their choice at *The University of Adelaide*. Upon achievement of the required entry score for their nominated degree program, students are given entry into the university for the next intake period.

Certificate IV in Tertiary Preparation Program (TTP)

- CertIV in TTP prepares students for entry into an Eynesbury Diploma. It is designed for students who have completed the equivalent of Year 11 at an Australian high school and/ or need to undertake further study before starting a diploma.

Diplomas in Business, IT and Engineering (EIBT)

- EIBT Diplomas introduce students to the fundamental knowledge required to successfully undertake undergraduate degree programs at *The University of Adelaide* or the *University of South Australia*.

Eynesbury College Academy of English (ECAE)

- The ECAE provides high-quality English Language programs that are taught by qualified Teachers of English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL).
